Should snow be removed from shrubs?

If there is a light dusting of snow it's not necessary to remove it from the trees or shrubs.

However, if there is a heavy snowfall (6"+), that poses the risk of branches breaking, follow the recommendations below.

How to remove snow from shrubs if there is heavy snowfall:

Gently brush the snow off by hand or use a broom to carefully remove it.

- DO NOT SHAKE THE BRANCHES, they are brittle at this time of year & may break easily
- Do not disturb any limbs that are frozen to the ground - allow ice to melt instead of attempting to remove it

If the damage is minimal they will have to be removed as soon as possible and/or at the appropriate time of year.

Winter Tree Pruning

Winter tree pruning is the process of removing branches from trees while they're dormant.



What would be pruned?

- Dead or dying branches
- Unwanted branches
- Thicker branches

Why would you prune in the winter?

- Prevents falling limbs
- Encourages growth
- Reduces risk of disease

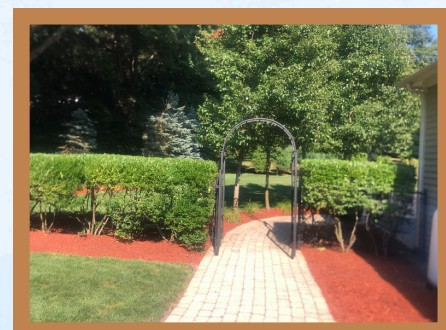
